Eagle River Secondary- Restart Plan (for June 1, 2020)



Hello Eagle River Secondary Students and Families,

Minister of Education, Rob Fleming has announced that schools will be returning to in-person instruction on a voluntary part-time basis beginning June 1st.



Secondary schools will be inviting students to come to school once a week starting the first week of June. This is an invitation only and not mandated or required. Please rest assured, teachers will be continuing to support home learning if your child chooses not to come to school.

If you have not responded to the district survey (sent to parents last week) and would like your child to attend school one day a week for the month of June, please complete the survey or call the office as soon as possible to make arrangements.

Only students that have said that they would like to return to school in the survey will be permitted on school premises or to ride the bus. Students may also set up appointments to meet with staff. The staff will work with the office to ensure that we are adhering to our strict occupancy numbers.

When students attend school on their invited day (see the schedule on the last page), teachers and CEAs will assist and support students with the work that has been assigned through home learning. There will be no new instruction provided in addition to the home learning assignments. There is no ABCD block rotation. Strict health and safety protocols will be followed at all times.

Here are some other considerations to keep in mind:

- Students will remain in their learning space for the entire day (ie. they won't move from room to room or desk to desk) yet, we do understand that students will need movement within the learning centre.
- We are encouraging students to bring their own device to school (ie. personal Chromebook, laptop...)
- If a student is done their work for the day, they are able to leave the building (they will, however, not be permitted back into the building). They are asked to sign out at the main doors by the gym.
- All lockers have been locked students will need to keep their personal belongings with them.
- Students to practice social distancing
- Gym will be closed.
- Outside doors will be locked at all times. All staff and student access will come through the main doors.
- Students are only allowed to fill their own water bottles at the fountain.
- There should be minimal student travel in the hallways except for students going to the washroom.
- Students will get lunch at the regular time. Students must leave through the main doors by the gym and sign out. They will be asked to sign in upon returning from lunch.

Arrival/Departure Process:

- Pylons will be arranged outside of the school. Students will need to line up at a pylon in order to enter the school. The sign in process will begin at 9:10 am. Children showing symptoms of COVID-19 or with a temperature greater than 38°C will not be allowed in the lineup. Parents, please keep your child at home if they are sick (i.e. fever, coughing...). Health care screening will be completed each day prior to the child being granted access. Students that do not pass the health check will be quarantined until parents arrive for pick up.
- Students and staff will be required sanitize their hands immediately upon entry into the school and will be encouraged to wash their hands regularly throughout the day.
- Students will go directly to their assigned learning centre and will remain in their assigned classrooms at all times when in the building (unless they need to go to the bathroom –specific student bathrooms will be assigned).
- If a child gets sick while at school, parents will be asked to come to the school to pick their child up.
